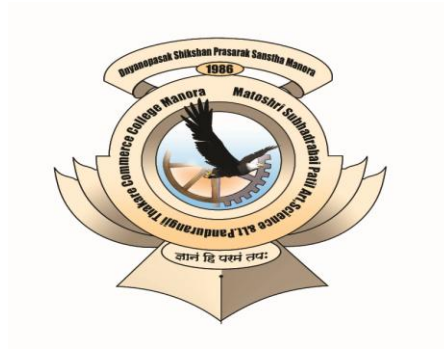


Summary


